Membership fees were set at the Annual General Meeting.
Memberships are valid from 1st January 2012 to 31st December 2012.

Family Membership entitles the privileges of Membership to all members of a family at the same address i.e. husband, wife, and all the children. All members of the family must be registered by including their details below.

Below are the club's rules governing supermoto use of the track by members – please obey them and ask that other members at the track to do so too. These are in addition to the actual track day or race day regulations.

- 1) Outside of controlled practice on race weekends and during the race programme, the track may only be used by **MEMBERS** of East of Scotland Kart Club on designated Supermoto days. Membership only applies to whoever is named on your membership form and holds a valid membership card. If someone is caught on the track who is not a member, the person whom allowed them on shall be automatically banned.
- 2) All persons using the track must wear full safety equipment as per regulations.
- 3) Bikes must comply with the current AMCA and Crail technical regulations.
- 4) Riders **MUST ONLY EXIT** via the exit lane, i.e. they **MUST NOT EXIT** the track via the dummy grid.
- 5) Drivers must drive slowly and must stop before the end of the exit lane where marked by the line and **STOP** sign. They **MUST NOT DRIVE** through to the dummy grid.
- 6) Practice sessions will be run as per the day's schedule.
- 7) Riders must not practice unless there is at least one other full club member present over 16 years of age and are strongly recommended to have a mobile phone with them to call for help if needed.
- 8) If you are involved in an accident on ESKC premises that requires treatment, you must contact a committee member of the club at your earliest opportunity.
- 9) Riders are required to lock the gate after entry and exit. They are also required to inspect the track, pit lane and dummy grid for obstructions and displaced tyre walls prior to using the track and also tidy up any rubbish.

I, as the main member agree to be bound by the rules (one to nine) above along with any supplementary rules. I will also be responsible for others in my membership obeying the same rules (one to nine) above while using the ESKC track.
